

# Alim

**Alim** (*ʿAlīm*<sup>عالم</sup>, also anglicized as *Aleem*) is one of the names of God in Islam, meaning "*All-Knowing*". Also used as a personal name, as short form of Abdul Alim, "*Servant of the All-Knowing*":
